Five easy steps to great financial service.

Step 1 Open your Keystone Savings Bank checking account with an initial deposit of \$100 or more, your savings account with \$25 or more. Ask for your ATM or debit card and order a box of checks. Visit your local branch to open your account today. Make note of your new account number here _____ and the Keystone Savings Bank routing number 073921682.

Step 2 Stop using your old account at the other financial institution and let all your outstanding checks clear. This might take up to 10 days. Destroy your old unused checks, deposit slips and your old ATM or Debit cards.

Step 3 Change any direct deposits you might have. Fill out the attached Direct Deposit form and give it to your payroll department, the Social Security Administration, your retirement plan, or any other source of Direct Deposit. Include a new deposit slip or voided check from your new Keystone Savings Bank account.

Step 4 Change any automatic payments or withdrawals. Use the automatic withdrawal form to change any automatic withdrawals or payment services. Don't forget any payments that use your old debit card number.

Step 5 Close your old account by sending the attached form to your old bank – no need for you to stop by. Your old bank will send you a check for the remaining balance in your account. That is it. Now you have service at a financial institution working with you and for you.
